Oasis Day Camp was the highlight of our summer! Over 80 children attended the camp, with 30+ of these children being sponsored due to financial needs.



mobilization = assessment

How does a person evaluate God's leading into cross-cultural ministry?

While there's no single answer to this question, there are factors to look at.

Each individual, and each organization, will have different circumstances to consider. At World Team, we explore the 4 C's with individuals who express an interest in missions.

Calling: ALL of us are called primarily to God - to know and love Him! He desires that ALL be saved! In that context, we explore His secondary calling - a role that uses our gifts to fulfill His will. How have my life experiences shaped my desire to see God's "Kingdom come" in a cross-cultural context?

Character: Closely related to calling, one's character is to reflect the character

of God. Is the fruit of the Spirit evident in my life? Is God gaining control in all areas of my existence? Am I conformed to the image of Christ?

Competencies: What gifts, experiences, and service opportunities have I enjoyed - both in and out of the local church? How could these relate to forming part of a church planting team in a cross-cultural context? Would others affirm having witnessed this in me?

Chemistry: Who am I, and what kind of situation (location, work environment, relationship setting) do I prefer? If I could serve anywhere, what would I choose?
