



Bringing a distinct cultural immersion & missions experience to the GTA

SPARK! helps Christians from all walks of life discover their call to missions.

Missions is not separate from the Church or her members - each one of us has the privilege and responsibility of seeing God's Church fulfill her mission.

World Team's SPARK! program brings a unique missions training and discovery opportunity for Bible colleges, seminaries, and the local church. SPARK! is an intentional discipleship curriculum that brings team discovery and participation to the forefront. Together we address fundamental questions such as: "What is missions? What is the call to missions? What is church planting?"

In addition to the training sessions, SPARK! immerses participants within one of World Team's local, cross-cultural church planting initiatives.

Through module training and experiential learning SPARK! aims to provide a distinct missions education and cultural immersion experience in the Greater Toronto Area.

Module 1: The BIG Picture

Providing a working knowledge of the people group & missions field in the GTA. Discussing missions prep, fundraising, & creating prayer teams.

The first module explores the religious, historical and cultural perspectives of the

target people group in Toronto. We introduce participants to the host missionary for the SPARK! Weekend Missions Trip and provide a safe environment to discuss difficult or uncomfortable questions as they prepare for cultural immersion.

SPARK! is:

1x general information session

4x three hour training modules

1 x weekend missions "field trip"

1x three hour debrief session

Module 2: Team Dynamics

Providing tools for building ministry teams.

Serving in teams reflects the very nature of God. Participants will review the Biblical importance of teamwork and explore Team Building tools. Ongoing team building & spiritual development continue throughout the remaining modules.

Module 3: Effective CP

Exploring apostolic ministry, core values & World Team's Church Planting Continuum in a cross cultural environment.

This module lays the groundwork for a healthy and holistic understanding of God's purposes in church planting & discipleship. Participants explore how World Team's ethos relates directly to the Biblical mandate of missions.

Module 4: Prayer & Worship

Embracing the value of Prayer, Worship, & dependency on Christ in Missions.

A Prayerful & Worshipping heart is a vital characteristic in the life of any Christ follower, disciple-maker, or missionary. As the SPARK! team finalizes its preparations they will gather with their prayer partners to enter into a special time of worship & praying through Scripture.

Weekend Missions Field Trip

Learning first hand about a foreign culture, religion, and what's involved to bring Gospel Transformation amongst that unreached people group.

Switching off all cell phones and removing other distractions, participants are immersed in a cross-cultural experience to serve alongside a local missionary. The team explores the lessons taught from each module in a cross-cultural church planting context.

Debrief Session: What Now?

Understanding how to debrief and exploring what's next in your missions involvement

This final module enables participants to voice their perspectives of the SPARK! experience in a safe environment and invites each person to consider the next steps in applying lessons learned to their lives, their church, their community, and in God's mission to the nations. Ongoing follow up will be conducted with interested participants.
