World Team

World Team is an interdenominational Christian mission agency with more than 350 workers sharing the Gospel in 28 countries. We place innovative teams among unreached peoples with a goal of seeing disciples brought into communities of faith that will multiply and impact the world for Jesus Christ.

Position Summary

This is a one year contract position with possible renewal. The Mobilizer works in conjunction with the Mobilization Team to recruit, assess and process potential candidates for cross-cultural ministry through World Team.

Qualifications

Organizational skills, administrative competence, and strong interpersonal skills are important to this role. The ideal candidate has the capacity to represent World Team to those investigating their Great Commission call, coach them in their search and assist them in moving to the next steps in the process leading to a decision to attend World Team Assessment or engage in an internship. The Mobilizer should be a mature Christian with some exposure to missiological principles. Cross-cultural experience is beneficial. She or he has a passion for missions and is in agreement with World Team's statement of faith.

The ideal candidate has:

- 1-3 years of experience in mobilizing or similar networking background
- Strong networking and collaborative leadership skills
- Solid communication skills
- Proven ability to multitask, meet deadlines, and work independently as well as collaboratively
- Willingness to travel and to work evenings and weekends as needed
- Active membership in a local church, participating in an accountability group and/or a discipleship relationship

General Responsibilities

Mobilizers work on a team to meet goals, recruit target audiences, cast a vision for missions for large and small groups, and create mobilization opportunities/networks. Mobilizers will:

- Develop and foster networking relationships (instructors, students, church leaders/members, graduates, organizations, WT alums, etc.) within assigned areas to build a referral/social network that engages people with World Team.
- Create, schedule and conduct presentations, as well as generate leads through events to further develop a World Team mobilization network.
- Talk with potential candidates to ensure that interested candidates submit the documentation necessary for candidacy programs according to established deadlines.
- Follow up with new contacts by implementing the recruitment/discipleship cycle and decision making process that is in place to achieve recruitment goals. Maintain acceptable performance in key areas, including contacts per week/month, presentation rate, lead-to-conversion rates, and event lead conversion.

World Team Doctrinal Statement

WE AFFIRM:

SCRIPTURE: that the sixty-six books of the Bible are the written word of God, verbally inspired by the Holy Spirit, without error in the original manuscripts, and the final authority in all matters of faith and conduct. (II Tim. 3:14-17; II Pet. 1:20, 21; Ps. 19:7-12)

GOD: that there is only one true God, eternally existing in three Persons - Father, Son and Holy Spirit - equal and harmonious in every respect, yet distinct in relation to the divine functions. God is the Creator and Sustainer of all things. (Jn. 8:12-59; 14:8-17)

PERSON OF THE FATHER: that God the Father is the sovereign, holy and merciful Lord who judges righteously, and who in love pursues the redemption of His fallen creation. (Ps. 139; Isa. 40; Jn. 3:16-21)

PERSON OF JESUS CHRIST: that God the eternal Son became a man through the virgin birth, uniting perfect deity and true humanity in one Person forever. His virgin birth was a miraculous work of the Holy Spirit. He lived a sinless life, was crucified, rose bodily from the dead, and ascended into heaven as Lord of all. He now intercedes for believers and will return personally and visibly to receive them, to establish His Kingdom, and to rule in righteousness and peace. (Matt. 1:18-25; Jn. 1:1-18; I Cor. 15:1-8; Col. 1:15-23; Heb. 4:14-16; Rev. 19:11-20:6)

PERSON OF THE HOLY SPIRIT: that God the Holy Spirit glorifies the Father and the Son in all that He does, not calling attention to Himself. His work includes convicting and regenerating sinners, baptizing all believers into the body of Christ at the time of regeneration, living in them, enabling them to live a life of obedient faith, and equipping and empowering them for service and witness. (Eph. 5:18-21; Gal. 5:22-23, Jn. 14-16; Rom. 8)

HUMANITY: that God created man and woman in His own image, and they became separated from God through their disobedience. Consequently, every human being is born a sinner, unwilling and unable to please God. Therefore, even those who have never heard the truth about God and His provision for salvation are lost. (Gen. 1-3; Rom. 3, 4)

SALVATION: that eternal salvation is wholly a work of God. God, out of His abundant grace, forgives sinners when they repent of their sin and put their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as the Son of God who died for them and rose from the dead. Jesus assumed their punishment for sin, credits His righteousness to those who believe, and brings them into eternal relationship with God as His children. (Rom. 5; 10:8-10)

SANCTIFICATION: that believers are declared holy in standing before God on the basis of the finished work of Christ. However, until they are glorified, when they are with the Lord, they are to grow in godliness as they submit to Christ's lordship, live in Christian community and are filled (controlled and empowered) by the Holy Spirit. (II Pet. 3:14-18; Rom. 8:28-30; Heb. 10:10; Eph. 5:18)

THE CHURCH: that the Church universal as the Body of Christ is under His Headship and is composed of all believers. It is made visible by local communities of believers organized for corporate worship, edification, fellowship, and the continuation of Christ's mission on earth. God gives spiritual gifts and leaders to the Church for its edification. The two God-ordained symbolic rites of the Church are believers' baptism and the Lord's supper. (Matt. 16:18; Eph. 3:8-11, 20-21; 4:11-16; Matt. 28:19; Luke 22:19)

RESURRECTION: that there will be a final bodily resurrection of all persons: believers will be raised to eternal life and conscious fellowship with God; unbelievers will be raised to eternal punishment and conscious separation from God. (Eccl. 12:14; Dan. 12:2-4; I Cor. 15; II Cor. 5:1-10)

SATAN AND SPIRITUAL CONFLICT: that Satan and other fallen angels are real, have personality, and are enemies of God and destroyers of men. While they were defeated at the cross and are limited in operation, they still engage in spiritual battle against God's people and against His purpose until the final day of judgment. Through Christ believers can live victoriously in this struggle with the forces of evil. (Eph. 6:10-18; 2:1-3; Heb. 2:14-18; Jam. 4:6-7)

MISSION: that Christ commissioned the Church to communicate to all people by verbal witness, godly living, and acts of compassion, the Good News of God's redemptive love and provision of salvation. It is the solemn responsibility of all believers to work with Christ in fulfilling the commission of making disciples among all peoples. (Matt. 28:16-20; Acts 1:6-11)
